

Product Efficiency and Lifespan

The following diagrams demonstrate the number of laundry balls you need according to your washer type and the lifespan of the laundry ball according to your wash schedule.

Number of laundry balls required according to washer capacity:

A regular capacity washer (4.0 cubic feet) typically holds 12 to 18 lbs / 8-6 kg of laundry per load. Large capacity washers (4.5 cubic feet) typically hold about 20-36 lbs / 9-16 kg.

1 Laundry Ball	Regular Capacity 12-18 lbs / 6-8 kg
2 Laundry Balls	Large Capacity 20 - 36 lbs / 9-16kg

Lifespan of Laundry Ball to number of washes per week

Washes per WEEK:	1	2	3	4	5	6	7
lifespan in DAYS:	2,555	1,277	852	639	511	426	365
lifespan in WEEKS:	364	182	121	91	73	61	52
lifespan in MONTHS:	84	42	28	21	17	14	12
lifespan in YEARS:	7	3.5	2.33	1.75	1.4	1.17	1

Example: If you wash 1 load per day, your laundry ball will last for 1 year.

Lifespan of Laundry Ball to number of washes per day.

Washes per DAY:	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
lifespan in DAYS:	365	182	122	91	73	61	52	46
lifespan in WEEKS:	52	26	17	13	10.4	8.6	7.4	6.5
lifespan in MONTHS:	12	6	4	3	2.4	2	1.7	1.5
lifespan in YEARS:	1	0.5	0.33	0.25	0.2	0.17	0.14	0.13

Example: If you wash 2 loads per day, your laundry ball will last for 6 months.

Regenerative sun exposure times according to your wash schedule.

Washes per day	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Every (# of days)	30	15	10	7.5	6	5	4.3	3.75

Example: If you wash 2 loads per day, the laundry ball should be exposed to the sun for 2 hours every 15 days. Sunlight is the quickest way to remove the moisture content of the ceramics, but if there is no sun, the laundry ball may also be left in a dry area of the home; however, a longer drying time is required (4-6 hours).
